I am working on my lesson plans. This is the first of two I plan to demo that day. I am starting the second painting today, a spring flowing over the rocks at a park in Neosho, Missouri.

You might pass the word to the group to look at this painting closely with the purpose of trying to figure out how it was approached.

I am not going to require the students buy these paints for the workshop. However, I am passing the information on in case they want to add these colors to their pallet. They are all very effective colors for paintings of this type, a wide range of blues and aquas.

Ultramarine Blue
Indianthrone Blue
Indigo
Antwerp
Cobalt
Cerulean Blue
Joe's Blue (probably only available from Cheap Joe's)

I have found it helpful to make a swath of these colors on a piece of scrap paper to use as reference until I learn these better.

No big deal if they don't have these, just mentioning them in case they are interested in adding them.
